Second Lesson • Romans 15:4-13



While we think about the ways in which Jesus comes to us, we can have "patient endurance" and "rejoicing" because of God's gift of faith through the Holy Spirit.

Indeed, whatever was written in the past was written for our instruction, so that, through patient endurance and the encouragement of the Scriptures, we would have hope. ⁵And may God, the source of patient endurance and encouragement, grant that you agree with one another in accordance with Christ Jesus, ⁶so that with one mind, in one voice, you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

⁷For this reason, accept one another as Christ also accepted you to the glory of God. ⁸For I am saying that Christ became a servant of those who are circumcised for the sake of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs. ⁹He also did this so that the Gentiles would glorify God for his mercy, as it is written:

For this reason I will praise you among the Gentiles,
 and I will sing to your name. (Psalm 18:49)

¹⁰And again it says:

Rejoice, you Gentiles, with his people. (Deuteronomy 32:43)


¹¹And again:

Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles,
and let all the peoples give him praise. (Psalm 117:1)


¹²And again Isaiah says:

There will be a Root of Jesse,
and he is the one who will rise up to rule the Gentiles;
on him the Gentiles will place their hope. (Isaiah 11:10)

Gospel • Luke 4:16–22



Jesus began His ministry on earth by going to worship and preaching the good news to those in attendance. Through Him, the “year of the Lord’s favor” had come. Every time we hear God’s Word, Jesus comes to us today! This makes every day a day “of the Lord’s favor.”

[Jesus] went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. As was his custom, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day and stood up to read. ¹⁷The scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written:

¹⁸The Spirit of the Lord is on me,
because he anointed me to preach good news to the poor.

He has sent me to proclaim freedom to the captives
and recovery of sight to the blind,
to set free those who are oppressed,

¹⁹and to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor. (Isaiah 61:1–2)

²⁰He rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him. ²¹He began to tell them, "Today, this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

²²They all spoke well of him and were impressed by the words of grace that came from his mouth. And they kept saying, "Isn't this Joseph's son?" (EHV)
