


Call to Worship · Trinity Sunday

- P Hear us as we pray, O Lord:



First Lesson · Numbers 6:22-27

The one, true, and living God reveals Himself as the Holy Trinity in the Old Testament as well as the New. The common final blessing of our worship service is a clear example of "one Lord" revealing Himself and His work in three equal parts.

The LORD told Moses 23 to speak to Aaron and to his sons and to tell them to bless the Israelites with these words:

Gospel · Matthew 28:16-20


As Jesus commissions His disciples to go out Baptizing and teaching God's Word, He sends them in the name of the only true God: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit who is three persons yet one God.

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had directed them.
¹⁷When they saw him, they worshipped him, but some hesitated because they were uncertain.
¹⁸Jesus approached and spoke to them saying, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
¹⁹Therefore go and gather disciples from all nations by baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and by teaching them to keep all the instructions I have given you. And surely I am with you always until the end of the age." (EHV)

P This is the Gospel of our Lord.

Confession of Faith · The Athanasian Creed

[This is one of the three creeds (statement-of-faith) which is universally believed by all Christians.]

P Having heard the Word of God, we confess our holy faith using the words of the Athanasian Creed:

Whoever wishes to be saved must, above all else, hold to the true Christian faith.

- **@** Whoever does not keep this faith pure and undefiled in all points, will certainly perish forever.
- P And the Christian faith is this: That we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity; Neither confounding the Persons; nor dividing the Essence.
- For there is one Person of the Father; another of the Son; and another of the Holy Spirit.
- Prove each Person—the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—is distinct, but the deity of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit is one, equal in glory and coeternal in majesty.
- **@** What the Father is, so is the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- P The Father is uncreated; the Son is uncreated; and the Holy Spirit is uncreated.
- **⚠** The Father is eternal; the Son is eternal; and the Holy Spirit is eternal.
- P And yet they are not three eternals; but one eternal. There are not three uncreated, nor three infinites; but one uncreated, and one infinite.
- So also, the Father is Almighty; the Son is Almighty; and the Holy Spirit is Almighty. And yet they are not three Almighties; but one Almighty.

- P So the Father is God; the Son is God; and the Holy Spirit is God. And yet they are not three Gods; but one God.
- Likewise the Father is Lord; the Son is Lord; and the Holy Spirit is Lord. And yet they are not three Lords, but one Lord.
- P For just as we are compelled by Christian truth to acknowledge every Person by himself to be God and Lord, so are we forbidden by the Christian religion to say, "There are three Gods, or three Lords."
- The Father is made of none, neither created, nor begotten. The Son is of the Father alone; not made, nor created; but begotten. The Holy Spirit is of the Father and of the Son; neither made, nor created, nor begotten; but proceeding.
- P So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits.
- **(4)** And in this Trinity none is before, or after another; none is greater, or less than another.
- P But the whole three Persons are coeternal, and coequal. So that in all things, as said before; the Unity in Trinity, and the Trinity in Unity, is to be worshipped.
- **@** Whoever wishes to be saved must have this conviction of the Trinity.

Graciously help those who are assaulted by the devil and who are in peril of death. Be the strength of those who are suffering for the sake of Christ's holy name. Grant that we may live together in peace and prosperity. Grant us good and seasonable weather, and bless us with upright Christian wisdom in all that we do.

© O Lord, be with all in distress. Hear their prayers to the honor of Your Name.

P We especially commend to Your care and keeping this Your congregation which You have bought at a great price. Keep us all from offenses and bind us together in the unity of Your holy love. Grant that the little ones who are baptized in Your name may be brought up in Your fear. At Your table, give those who commune with You peace and life everlasting.

Let all rejoice who take refuge in You. Let them sing for joy because You protect them.


