First Lesson: Jeremiah 20:7-13

(The faithful prophet, Jeremiah, proclaimed the *Lord's judgment against sin. On the* one hand, he wanted to quit preaching to avoid persecution. On the other hand, he *couldn't hold back. Spirit*-borne zeal for his Lord burned within his heart. The same forces are in us as we pray for our nation. To whom can we turn for help? We confidently commit our cause to the Lord Almighty.)

⁷You persuaded me, Lord, and I was persuaded. You are stronger than I am, and you prevailed. I have become a laughingstock all day long, and everyone mocks me. ⁸Whenever I speak, I call out. I call out, "Violence and destruction!" because the word of the Lord has brought me insult and mockery all day long. ⁹If I say, "I will not mention him or speak in his name any more," then there is a burning fire in my heart, shut up in my bones, and I am weary of holding it in. I cannot!

¹⁰I hear many whispering, "Terror on every side!" "Denounce him! Let's denounce him," say all my close friends, those who are watching for my fall. "Perhaps he will

be persuaded, then we will prevail against him and we will take our revenge on him."

¹¹But the Lord is with me like a fearsome warrior. So my persecutors will stumble and they will not prevail. They will be utterly ashamed because they have failed. Their eternal dishonor

will never be forgotten. ¹²Lord of Armies, you who test the righteous, who see the heart and the mind, let me see your vengeance on them, for I have revealed my cause to you. ¹³Sing to the Lord! Praise the Lord, for he has delivered the life of the needy from the grasp of the wicked. Evangelical Heritage Version[®] (EHV)

The Gospel Lesson: Matthew 10:24-33

(Jesus plainly tells us about the crosses we will bear as his disciples. We can expect the world to treat us no better than it treated our Master. What a comfort to know that our life, death, and eternal future are in the hands of a God who gives loving attention to creatures far less significant than we are! He takes careful inventory of the smallest details of our lives. Therefore, we are bold and cheerful in proclaiming his gospel in a hostile world.)

²⁴"A disciple is not above his teacher, nor is a servant above his master. ²⁵It is enough for the disciple to be like his teacher and the servant like his master. If the master of the house was called Beelzebul, how much more the members of his household!

²⁶"So do not be afraid of them, because there is nothing concealed that will not be revealed, and nothing hidden that will not be made known. ²⁷What I tell you in the dark, speak in the daylight; and what you hear whispered in your ear, proclaim from the housetops. ²⁸Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, fear the one who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

²⁹"Are not two sparrows sold for a small coin? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground without the knowledge and consent of your Father. ³⁰And even the hairs of your head are all numbered. ³¹So do not be afraid. You are worth more than many sparrows.

³²"Everyone who confesses me before others, I will also confess before my Father who is in heaven. ³³But whoever denies me before others, I will also deny before my Father who is in heaven." (EHV)

The Confession of Faith – The Nicene Creed

¹Everyone must submit to the governing authorities. For no authority exists except by God, and the authorities that do exist have been established by God. ² Therefore the one who rebels against the authority is opposing God's institution, and those who oppose will bring judgment on themselves.

³ For rulers are not a terror to good conduct, but to evil. Would you like to have no fear of the one in authority? Do what is good, and you will receive praise from him, ⁴ because he is God's servant for your benefit. But if you do wrong, be afraid, because he does not carry the sword without reason. He is God's servant,

a punisher to bring wrath on the wrongdoer. ⁵ Therefore it is necessary to submit, not only because of wrath, but also because of conscience. (EHV)
